

Minnesota Statute 169.42 states that no person shall throw, deposit, place, or dump, or cause to be thrown, deposited, placed, or dumped upon any street or upon any public or privately owned land adjacent to without the owner's consent any snow or ice upon any such street or highway. Any person violating the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

In other words, persons are not to place snow on any roadway or pull/push snow across roadways.

City Code also states that all snow and ice shall be removed from public sidewalks within 12 hours after the snow or other precipitation causing the condition has ceased to fall.
