CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**CALL TO ORDER**

- Mayor Pro Tem Ries called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

- The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

**ROLL CALL**

- Council Members present: John Ries, Dennis Terrell, Clete Frederick, and Ryan Short.
- Staff present: City Administrator Jennifer Bromeland and Deputy Clerk Kerry Rausch.

**APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

- Council Member Frederick moved, seconded by Council Member Terrell, to approve the agenda. Motion carried with Council Members Ries, Terrell, Frederick, and Short voting in favor.

**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Review and Consider Adoption of Resolution 2018-07: A Resolution Appointing Tim Auringer to Fill Vacant Eagle Lake Mayoral Seat
  - Administrator Bromeland explained the vacancy was created when former Mayor Brianna Anderson resigned due to moving out of city limits and that Tim Auringer served as Mayor from 2005-2017.
  - Mayor Pro Tem Ries opened the discussion to the public with comments being taken. Mayor Pro Tem Ries then explained the process for this appointment and the reason this process was taken.
  - Council Member Terrell moved, seconded by Council Member Short, to approve Resolution 2018-07 Appointing Tim Auringer as Mayor. Motion carried with Council Members Terrell, Frederick, Short, and Mayor Pro Tem Ries voting in favor.
  - Mayor Pro Tem Ries conducted the Oath of Office swearing Tim Auringer in as Mayor of Eagle Lake.
2. Review and Consider Approval of Offer of Employment to Full-Time Police Officer.
  - Administrator Bromeland updated Council stating that seven candidates were interviewed for the position of a full-time police officer. Dustin Jensen was hired by the city in November of 2014 as a part-time police officer and is the best fit for this position. Officer Jensen would begin at a Step 1 pay grade of \$19.99 per hour.
  - Council discussion included the need to ensure schedule meets budgetary needs.
  - Council Member Ries moved, seconded by Council Member Frederick, to approve hiring Dustin Jensen as a full-time police officer. Motion carried with Council Members Ries, Terrell, Frederick, Short, and Mayor Auringer voting in favor.
