Agenda

Treasurer Report

New Business

1. Fraze Park

- Bids have been received to asphalt a path from 3rd Street N. into park. This will be located from the street into the park. Extension of the path will review after park has been further programmed.
- Volleyball court location was been marked. Leon Depuydt submitted low bid for digging the area one foot deep. There will be two courts 30' x 60' each.
- A park sign will be installed on Cate Street and LeRay to promote location of park.
- The bathrooms construction bid for a block 16 x 16 building 16 x 16-price just under \$30,000, at 16 x 12 with less storage on back end. No electricity is planned but will have sky lights. This is designed as a minimum maintenance structure. Cost of project was discussed and as well as potential ways to minimize costs. Recommend to council is advised. Marj moved to recommend to council the construction of bathroom in Fraze Park once second bid has been received. Joan Back seconded the motion. Motion carried.

2. Lake Eagle Park

- Contact has been paid with a company who can treat the pond all summer at a cost of \$1800 for the year. It would be chemically treated with a natural chemicals.
- Goose control ideas were discussed.

- Issue with dogs in the parks was discussed and the need to remind residents that all dogs must remain on leash while in the park. It was also discussed to have the police do more patrol and issue tickets as needed.
- Input on options for a neighborhood park in the Eagle Heights area was requested.

3. New games

Several new game ideas for the parks was presented. Frisbee golf and Sabakiball had the most support from board members.

4. Park Lighting

Staff is looking at electrical LED lighting options for Lake Eagle Park. 6 lights could be \$3100 if we do the trenching.
