



Route 20 transitions to Kato Flex—another way to ride the bus with us

To help enhance transit service provided to Eagle Lake residents, Route 20 has transitioned to Kato Flex—another way to ride the bus with us.

Why Kato Flex?

- ◆ Kato Flex is a curb-to-curb service. Registered riders will be picked up at their address and dropped off anywhere Mankato bus service is provided.
- ◆ Schedule a service time that works for you between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- ◆ Currently, there's no cost to use Kato Flex because it's a pilot project.
- ◆ All buses are American Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible and equipped with bike racks.

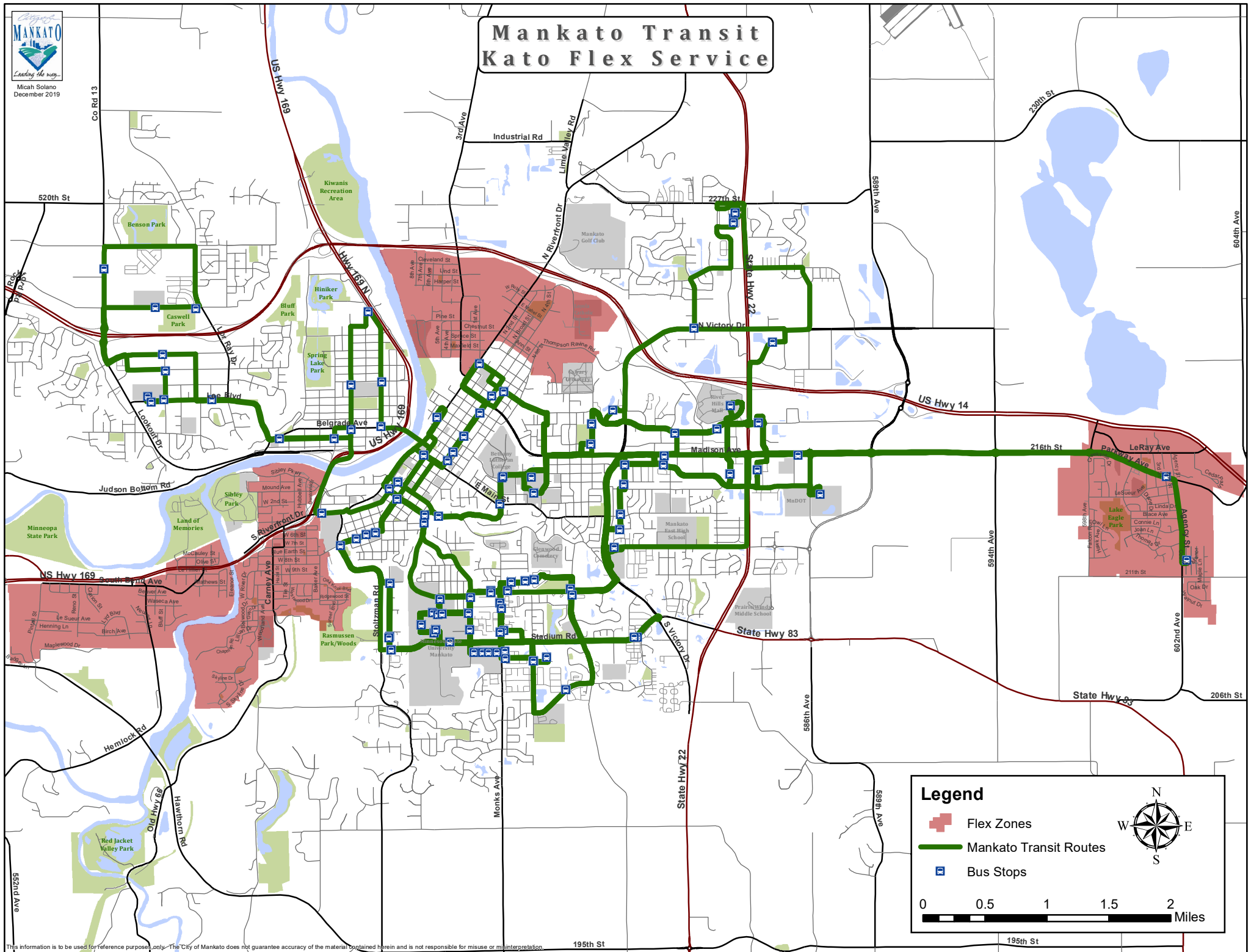
