Overview

As you know, the City of Eagle Lake is partnering with Blue Earth County to undertake the reconstruction of Agency Street (County State Aid Highway 27). The project includes complete street and utility reconstruction from Thomas Drive to Le Ray Avenue. This newsletter is intended to be informational. **Notices related to special assessments will be mailed separately from the City of Eagle Lake.**



Project Timeline

Competitive bids for the work will be received on March 31, 2021. We expect the project will be awarded to the lowest bidder by the City of Eagle Lake and Blue Earth County by April 14, 2021. More details of the proposed schedule will be known after a contractor is selected in the weeks to come.



Private Utility Relocations

Although the project has not been officially awarded, you should expect to see some construction activity soon. **CenterPoint Energy anticipates that its contractor will begin relocating the gas lines in the next 2-3 weeks.** You may also see other utility owners begin relocating their lines and poles in the near future.

This initial work is not under the direction or supervision of the City or County but is necessary to prepare for the proposed street and utility improvements. This work will result in some disruptive and messy conditions at times. We ask that you please be patient as the various contractors work to complete their individual portion of the improvements.
