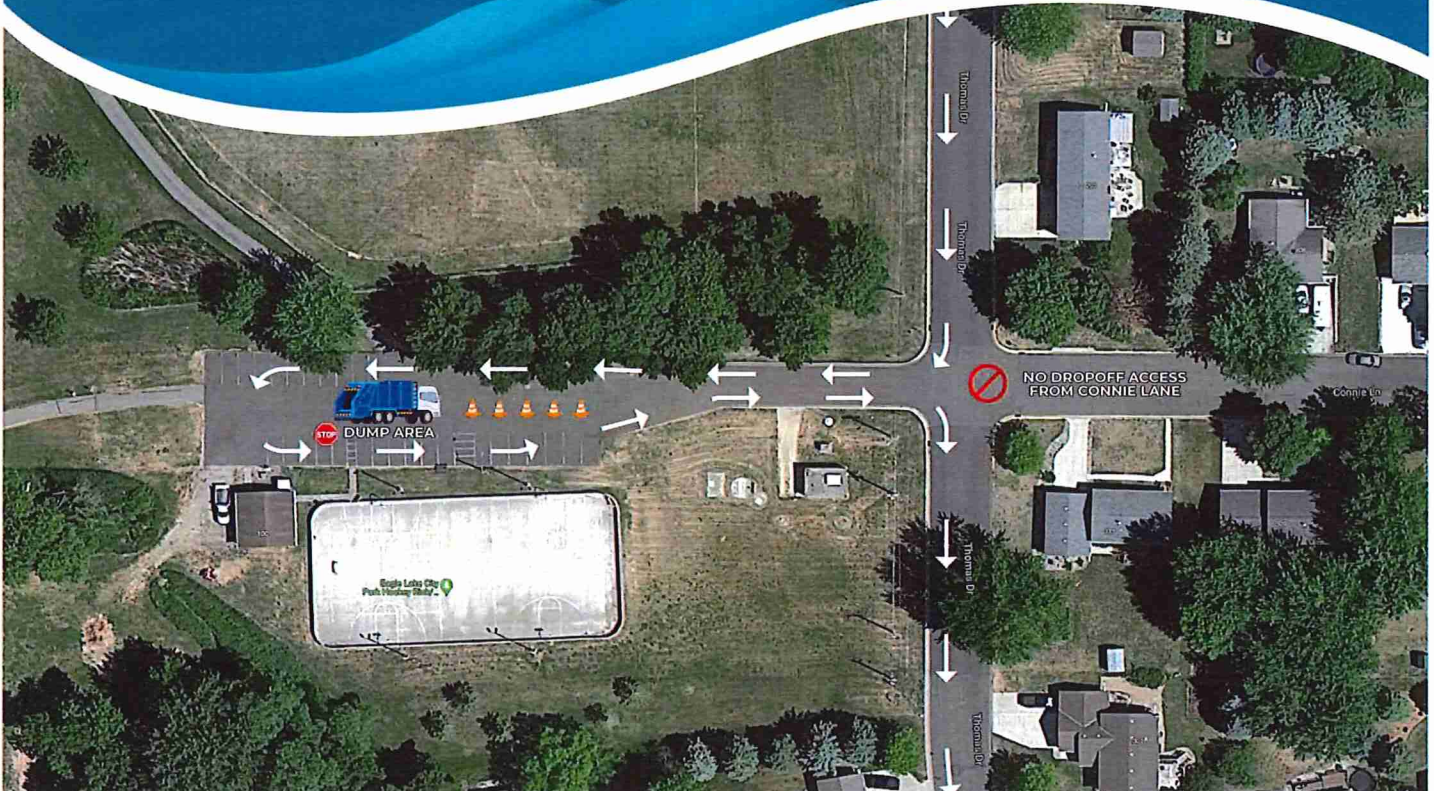


# CITY OF EAGLE LAKE SPRING CLEANUP

# SPRING CLEANUP

## UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Yard Waste

*Grass Clippings, Shrubs, Plants, Tree Limbs, Leaves, Branches, etc.*

Mattresses & Box Springs

TVs, Laptops, Computer Screens

Hazardous Waste

*Paints, Liquids, Chemicals, Batteries, etc.*

Motor Oil & Petroleum Products

*Oil Filters, Petroleum Products or Petroleum Product Containers*

Remodeling Materials

*Fluorescent Lights, Incandescent Light Bulbs, Cement, Asphalt, Drywall, Siding, Remodeling Demolition, or Construction Materials*

**BACKGROUND:** LJP Waste Solutions recently notified the City of Eagle Lake that they will not be offering a curbside cleanup this spring in any of the communities that they serve due to staffing shortages and not having enough staff to cover an extra Saturday needed for a curbside cleanup. Instead, LJP Waste Solutions will be holding a centralized drop-off location at Lake Eagle Park on Saturday, May 14th from 8am-noon.

Discussion took place at both the February 7th and March 7th City Council meetings regarding this change. Recognizing the importance of offering residents a curbside cleanup, alternate haulers were contacted. Unfortunately, the City was not able to secure another hauler willing to provide a curbside cleanup this spring.

The City's contract with LJP Waste Solutions states that the annual cleanup shall be held each spring but does not specifically state that the cleanup will be "curbside". Historically, the spring cleanup has been held "curbside" except for the spring cleanup during 2020, which was converted to a drop-off cleanup due to COVID related safety concerns. A spring curbside cleanup resumed during the spring of 2021.

LJP Waste Solutions indicated in their notice that they hope to be able to return to a curbside cleanup in 2023.

According to LJP Waste Solutions, much more staff is needed for a curbside cleanup compared to a centralized drop off location which requires much less staff.
