**CALL TO ORDER**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m.

**NEW BUSINESS**

- The Park Board met at the ice skating rink.
- The sign for the adventure park will be designed and the tables will be installed.
- The Park Board will host Popsicles in the Park on Thursday, July 13 from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. in conjunction with the Bike Rodeo and Tator Days. This will be a promotional event introducing residents to the Adventure park.
- The ice rink's basketball hoops are used in the summer, especially in the evenings. Discussion included the need to lower or purchase adjustable height hoops for younger children.
- Frisbee Golf installation will be discussed with staff.
- Pool/Splash Pad group has formed and will be presenting information to the City Council. Discussed that a member of the Park Board should be on this citizen committee. Bridget Larson volunteered to be the Park Board liaison.
- Installation of a trail from N 3<sup>rd</sup> St into Frazee Park was discussed. It was determined that the trail should be located from the street to the restrooms and stay south of the tree line.
- Additional signage for Frazee Park should be considered to include information such as restrooms, volleyball courts, and connection to Sakatah Trail. Location of this signage could be along trail on Parkway Avenue.
- The Park Board would like staff to contact Jack Hoban, an area youth, who has an interest in skateboard parks to learn and gather ideas from him.
- The idea of dirt trails with mounds was discussed for bike riders.
- The need to educate the public on pond algae growth is discussed.
