CALL TO ORDER

TREASURER'S REPORT

The treasurer's report was presented. The Park Assigned balance does not yet reflect the purchase of new playground equipment.

BUSINESS

1. Review and Consider Possible Internship Opportunity with MNSU Parks and Recreation
It was decided to delay creating the internship position to allow time to develop guidelines and goals. The need to keep moving forward with this to allow for the person in the internship the opportunity to plan events and processes was also discussed.
2. Review and Discuss Promoting Sunflower Contest
The Park Board reviewed the information residents could be provided and decided this contest would be open to Eagle Lake residents only due to the limited number of seeds available for distribution. The Board discussed the possibility of finding businesses willing to donate gift certificates for different category winners. The staff will begin promoting this contest a couple of weeks before Mother's Day.
3. Update Regarding New Park Equipment
The equipment has been ordered and the company will do the installation. Discussion included the desire to find a way to preserve and display ketchup and mustard.
4. Update Regarding FREE Movie in the Park Event
Correspondence has been sent to businesses looking for sponsors for this event. The cost of the movie night is \$1200 and to date \$500 in donations have been received. Activities prior to the movie are being explored with the idea of a coloring contest and "troll hair". The Park Board was asked to mark their calendars to help work this event, which will be held Friday, June 22, 2018. Other items discussed included a live video feed showing people attending and the use of a drone for pictures, getting sound to the playground area while the kids are playing before the movie. This event is open to Eagle Lake and surrounding communities.
5. T-Ball Update
Jeremy Horkey provided Jennifer with his report asking that an email be sent out and information be put on the City's Facebook page information on T-ball sign up. Flyers will be brought to the school as well.
