**TREASURER'S REPORT**

**BUSINESS**

2. Nature Park Clean Up
  - Board members viewed the Nature Play Area to determine improvements needed after the winter.
3. Sunflower Seed Contest
  - Seeds will be distributed starting this week to those interested in participating.
4. Park Equipment Installation
  - Park equipment will be installed sometime in May.
5. Free Movie in Park Event
  - Event will be held June 22, 2017. Sponsor participation was enough to cover cost of event.
6. Gaga Ball Signage
  - Rules will be placed at the Gaga Ball stations located in both Lake Eagle and Frazee Parks.
7. Lake Eagle Park Pavilion
  - Discussion included the need to ask City Council to consider budgeting to replace the pavilion in Lake Eagle Park and add a small one in Frazee Park. Cost would need to be determined. Discussion included the need to determine if the Lake Eagle pavilion is shifting.
8. T-Ball Update
  - An update was provided on the number of children registered. Any excess funds collected will be donated to the Eagle Lake Community Development Foundation and the Park Board.
9. Other Items
  - Pickle Ball – staff will reach out to Community Education on this topic.
  - Frisbee Golf – Signs will be installed for the course this summer.
  - Tator Days – softball tournament may be brought back this year and excess proceeds will be donated to Eagle Lake Community Development Foundation and the Park Board.
  - Pond Dredging – measurements are taken to determine when dredging is indicated.
  - Warming House – park fitness group will utilize facility for equipment storage.
