Re: Public Works Building – Proposals to Repair Building

Following the recent vehicle accident at the Public Works building, the City has obtained three proposals for the necessary repairs:

- Rice Companies \$74,888
- WEB Construction \$75,740
- APX \$93,400

The City's insurer, League of Minnesota Cities Insurance Trust (LMCIT), has advised that the City may proceed with repairs using the contractor of its choice. However, LMCIT will reimburse the City up to the amount of the lowest qualifying bid, which was submitted by Rice Companies at \$74,888.

The City's insurance policy includes a deductible of \$2,500. LMCIT has indicated they will pursue subrogation against the responsible party and, if successful, may be able to recover the City's deductible.

Date: 7/11/2025

Scope:

- 1. Mobilize to site and set up equipment.
- 2. Demo damaged wall to expose footing/existing connections to allow new connection to be made.
- 3. Saw Cut and Hydrovac down to footing.
- 4. Remove and replace 3 panels on exterior concrete sidewalk.
- 5. Backfill, then place rebar and epoxy for concrete fill.
- 6. Grout base for installation of precast wall panel.
- 7. Install new 9" Architectural Insulated Wall to match existing as close as possible.
- 8. Caulk precast to precast wall panel joints inside and outside.
- 9. Furnish and install new 4.5" aluminum window system, glazed with 1" standard clear insulated
- 10. glass with low 'e' coating #2 surface operable window to match existing as close as possible. Estimated timeframe for receiving window is 16 weeks.
- 11. Remove and install new interior window sills to match existing as close as possible.
- 12. Remove existing shades and install new Lafayette Genesis Roller Shades Sheerweave 7000 Graphite with 5.5" Fascia.
- 13. Install new Duo Blinds Lafayette Genesis Duo Roller Shade Sheerweave 2000 5% White/Platinum and Sheerweave 7000 Graphite with 5.5" Fascia.
- 14. Remove and install new 4" vinyl base.
- 15. Recoat epoxy floors to match existing grey color and finish.
- 16. Paint 2 existing exterior walls to match white interior color as close as possible.
- 17. Final clean of office area only.
- 18. We have included \$500 for dumpster rental. If debris can be disposed of in owners dumpsters, fee will be credited back to owner.

Alternate:

1. Install Non-operable window to match existing as close as possible.

Requires:

1. Clear access for vehicles and equipment required for work to be performed.

Excludes:

- 1. Any item not specifically noted in the scope section of this proposal.
