Contestants must reside in Eagle Lake, MN and remain a resident throughout their reign as Miss Eagle Lake. (until next year's coronation.)

Contestants must be a Junior or Senior in High School for the upcoming school year.

There are so many wonderful businesses eager to sponsor you for this growth/development opportunity. Although a sponsor is not required at the time of application, each contestant is required to approach a local business and request/secure sponsorship prior to the first meeting date. In addition to personalizing your message to the prospective sponsor, be prepared to: A) communicate why you would like to participate in the Eagle Lake Royalty Coronation, B) share that sponsors will be acknowledged during the pageant and parade(s), and C) relay that the sponsorship fee is \$150. Sponsors must be a local business from Eagle Lake.

Miss Eagle Lake and Miss Eagle Lake Attendant(s) will be chosen by a judging panel. Contestants provide their own gown for the coronation ceremony. Contestants agree to properly care for and maintain pageant related items and/or property including sashes, crowns, etc.

Contestants agree to be positive role models and to lead by example during and after the competition. This includes refraining from smoking, vaping, drugs, and alcohol, and any involvement in criminal activity. Contestants found guilty of any of the above offenses will be removed from the pageant; winners will have their crown, sash, and scholarship revoked.

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Important Dates

All contestants must be available to participate in the community service impact project, fundraising/community events, and pageant meetings leading up to the week of Coronation and be free/available throughout the week of Tator Days. Specifics will be provided during the first meeting.
