WATER SERVICE LINE INVENTORY




City of Eagle Lake

The City of Eagle Lake is working to complete an inventory of all water service lines within the system. The goal of the inventory is to identify the material type of every service line with the ultimate goal of securing funding to remove lead pipes from the system. This inventory is required by the US Environmental Protection Agency and is scheduled to be complete in July 2024. We are asking residents to help with the process and perform a material survey.

You can identify your pipe material by checking your household water services connections inside your home, typically located between the meter and the floor of your basement. See photo below for reference.

What is a service line? A service line is the pipe connecting the water main to the interior plumbing in a building.

Types of Water Pipes

Use the guide below to determine your water pipe material.

LEAD

A dull, silver-gray color that is easily scratched with a coin. Use a magnet to detect the material - strong magnets will not cling to lead pipes.

GALVANIZED

A dull, silver-gray color. Use a magnet to detect the material - strong magnets will typically cling to galvanized pipes.

PLASTIC

Blue or black pipe.

COPPER

The color of a penny.
